



Interviews with 1,017 adult Americans conducted by telephone by Opinion Research Corporation on October 30-November 1, 2008. The margin of sampling error for results based on the total sample is plus or minus 3 percentage points.

The sample also includes 950 interviews among registered voters (plus or minus 3 percentage points) and 714 interviews among likely voters (plus or minus 3.5 percentage points).
