## FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT INVESTIGATIVE REPORT

On Thursday March 15, 2012, the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) received a request for assistance from Norm Wolfinger, State Attorney for the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit, requesting that FDLE assist their office with an inquiry into the February 26th 2012, shooting death of Trayvon Martin.

On Monday, April 2, 2012, at approximately 0819 hours, SA Moore received a call via cell from SAS Susan Kuhn providing instructions to call Assistant State Attorney (ASA) Bernie De-La-Rionda of the Duval County State Attorney Office (DCSAO). SA Moore made contact with ASA De La Rionda who provided limited information but requested assistance with an interview in the Miami-Dade and Broward County areas. ASA De-La-Rionda stated he would be arriving via American Airlines with an Investigator at approximately1045 hours at the Miami airport. SA Kristin Hoffacker was also assigned to assist with the detail and coordinated with Miami-Dade Police Department (MDPD) airport units to facilitate their arrival. The flight arrived approximately 1230 hours with ASA De La Rionda and SAO Investigator T C Osteen.
