█████ stated that there were people still inside her residence. Sgt. Jankowski and myself then searched the residence (this was Sgt. Jankowski's only involvement in this case), but found no one inside.

█████ then provided a sworn written statement of the following information: On 08/03/11 at approximately 1100 hours, she heard a knock at her front door, then she heard the door bell. █████ did not have a way to look out the front door, so she went up stairs and looked out the window, where she could see the outside of the front of her residence (Retreat View Cir). █████ saw a black male adult (wearing a blue shirt, and black shorts, with a short hair cut) standing at the front of her residence, ringing the door bell and knocking on the front door. █████ advised that she did not answer the front door, because she did not know the person. A few moments later, █████ again heard a knock at the front door followed by the door bell. She looked out the window again and noticed the same black male adult (this time the blue shirt was over his shoulder and he was wearing a black tank top), with another black male adult also wearing a black tank top and black shorts.

█████ said that she then called the police when she saw one of the unknown black males walk up to the rear sliding glass door of her residence. She then ran up stairs and locked herself into a bedroom. █████ advised that she could hear people inside her residence, and could see the door knob moving to the room that she was hiding. █████ said that she could hear them walking down the stairs when the police were knocking on the front door.

After the residence was searched █████ looked around her residence and advised the following items were missing: Canon EOS digital rebel xs camera black in color. Value \$600.00. Serial number █████ IMAC laptop computer silver in color. Value \$300.00. █████ advised that no one had permission to enter her residence or take any items and she wants to press charges.

I processed the scene for prints and was able to lift off of the rear sliding glass door, the living room TV set, and the upstairs bedroom computer screen (JB-1). All prints were turned into the Sanford Police Department for evidence. █████ stated that the rear sliding glass door was locked, however when I checked the door I could see that the lock on the door was not functional (the lock was not broken into, it was just not working). The camera was entered into FCIC/NCIC as stolen. There is no further information at this time. This case is being forwarded to Inv. Foshee who responded to the scene.

at 1305 Mrs. [REDACTED] returned my call. Mrs. [REDACTED] advised the only additional information she had to provide was her husband believed he saw a male matching the description she provided walking in their back yard approximately one week before the incident.

No additional information pertinent to the case was provided.

Inv. Foshee was successful in making contact with surrounding neighbors.

At this time there are no additional leads to follow, case will be inactive pending return of latent prints. I informed Mrs. [REDACTED] of this and she advised she understood.

at 1411 hours Mrs. [REDACTED] returned my call and advised she does not know Burgess nor did she ever allow him in or around her home.

On 10/05/2011 I received a message from Mrs. [REDACTED] requesting case information.

On 10/06/2011 I made contact with Mrs. [REDACTED] via phone and provided case information.

I generated a photo lineup utilizing CAFE. The lineup included Emmanuel Burgess and five other males with similar facial and physical characteristics.

at 1359 hours I made contact with Mrs. [REDACTED] at her residence. I presented Mrs. [REDACTED] a copy of the photo line up and without hesitation she identified Emmanuel Burgess as the male she saw at her door the day of the burglary and the same male who thirty minutes later returned and entered her home.

at 1400 hours I attempted to make contact with Burgess at his residence, however I met with negative results. [REDACTED] (father) answered the door and advised he would let [REDACTED] know I need to talk to him.

On 10/06/2011 [REDACTED] mother of [REDACTED] called and left a message requesting I call her back.

On 10/07/2011 I returned the call to Mrs. [REDACTED] and informed her I need to peak to [REDACTED] reference the case. Mrs. [REDACTED] advised she did not know where her son was at this time, but that he still lives with her. Mr. [REDACTED] advised she would let [REDACTED] know I need to speak with him.

at 1400 hours Deputy C. Johnson with the SCSO contacted me and advised [REDACTED] is currently on Conditional release form a level ten program after being released on 07/18/2011

On 10/12/2011 I distributed a photo lineup to SPD via email and placed copies in the briefing room.

Based on information and evidence obtained I am forwarding the case to the SAO requesting F.S.S 810.02 3a and 812.014 2c be filed against [REDACTED]

On 08/03/11 at approximately 1102 hours, I responded [REDACTED] Retreat View Cir in reference to suspicious person. Sanford Dispatch advised that the caller [REDACTED] (victim), could hear people inside her residence ([REDACTED] Retreat View Cir). [REDACTED] let me into the front door of the residence as Sgt. Jankowski went to the rear of the residence. Sgt. Jankowski advised that the rear sliding glass door was open (entry/exit point). [REDACTED] stated that there were people still inside her residence. Sgt. Jankowski and myself then searched the residence (this was Sgt. Jankowski's only involvement in this case), but found no one inside.

[REDACTED] then provided a sworn written statement of the following information: On 08/03/11 at approximately 1100 hours, she heard a knock at her front door, then she heard the door bell. [REDACTED] did not have a way to look out the front door, so she went up stairs and looked out the window, where she could see the outside of the front of her residence ([REDACTED] Retreat View Cir). [REDACTED] saw a black male adult (wearing a blue shirt, and black shorts, with a short hair cut) standing at the front of her residence, ringing the door bell and knocking on the front door. [REDACTED] advised that she did not answer the front door, because she did not know the person. A few moments later, [REDACTED] again heard a knock at the front door followed by the door bell. She looked out the window again and noticed the same black male adult (this time the blue shirt was over his shoulder and he was wearing a black tank top), with another black male adult also wearing a black tank top and black shorts.

[REDACTED] said that she then called the police when she saw one of the unknown black males walk up to the rear sliding glass door of her residence. She then ran up stairs and locked herself into a bedroom. [REDACTED] advised that she could hear people inside her residence, and could see the door knob moving to the room that she was hiding. [REDACTED] said that she could hear them walking down the stairs when the police were knocking on the front door.

After the residence was searched [REDACTED] looked around her residence and advised the following items were missing: Canon EOS digital rebel xs camera black in color. Value \$600.00. Serial number [REDACTED] IMAC laptop computer silver in color. Value \$300.00. [REDACTED] advised that no one had permission to enter her residence or take any items and she wants to press charges.

I processed the scene for prints and was able to lift off of the rear sliding glass door, the living room TV set, and the upstairs bedroom computer screen (JB-1). All prints were turned into the Sanford Police Department for evidence. [REDACTED] stated that the rear sliding glass door was locked, however when I checked the door I could see that the lock on the door was not functional (the lock was not broken into, it was just not working). The camera was entered into FCIC/NCIC as stolen. There is no further information at this time. This case is being forwarded to Inv. Foshee who responded to the scene.
