

**FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT
INVESTIGATIVE REPORT**

On Tuesday, April 3, 2012, Special Agent (SA) Luis Negrete of the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) obtained and reviewed a copy of the final report of autopsy on Trayvon Martin. The report was completed and submitted by Dr. Bao Shiping, Associate Medical Examiner, Office of the Medical Examiner, District 7 and 24. The report was prepared in reference to the February 26, 2012, shooting death of Trayvon Martin.

A copy of the report reflects that Dr. Shiping completed and signed the final report (Medical Examiner No. 12-24-0043). The case of death was listed as "gunshot wound of the chest" and the manner of death was "homicide".

FINAL DIAFNOSES AND FINDINGS: Penetrating Gunshot wound of the Chest.

- Entrance: Left chest, intermediate range
- Path of projectile: Skin, left anterior 5th intercostal space, pericardial sac right ventricle of heart, and right lower lobe of lung
- Direction of projectile: Directly, front to back
- Exit: None; fragments of the projectile recovered in pericardial sac and right pleural cavity
- Associated injuries: Entrance wound; perforation of pericardial sac, right ventricle of heart, right lower lobe of lung with bilateral pleural hemorrhage
- Postmortem radiograph: Metallic fragment of projectile identified

A review of the Lab report from NMS Labs revealed the following controlled substances in Martin's system at the time of his death.

Delta-9 THC	1.5 ng/mL
Delta-9 Carboxy THC	7.3 ng/mL
Cannabinoids	Presump Pos
